About your pack of Zelleta[®]

Each pack of Zelleta[®] contains 84 tablets presented in 3 x 28 blister pack strips, which is sufficient for three separate 28 day cycles of contraceptive cover.

One tablet of Zelleta[®] should be taken every day. As soon as you have completed one strip of tablets you should start the next blister pack of Zelleta[®] tablets, so that there are no gaps or pill free days.

Each box of Zelleta[®] also contains a detailed Patient Information Leaflet, which you should read carefully and put in a safe place. This covers important information such as: what you should do if you miss or are late taking a pill; information on other medicines or illnesses that could make your pill less effective; information on side effects that you might experience and what you should do if you experience one; which warning signs indicate that you should stop taking your pill and consult your doctor; and other important facts that you should know about when taking Zelleta[®] or any oral contraceptive pill.

About your Zelleta[®] prescription

Your doctor or other healthcare provider has prescribed Zelleta[®] as your oral contraceptive method.

Zelleta[®] is a combined oral contraceptive or birth control pill that is taken to prevent pregnancy. It contains Desogestrel 75 micrograms in each pill.

If you received Cerazette[®] previously

Zelleta[®] works in exactly the same way and contains exactly the same active ingredient at the same strength and dosage as Cerazette[®].

There is no difference in the effectiveness of Zelleta[®] in preventing pregnancy; you can take Zelleta[®] with confidence.

Apart from the change in the name, the design of your packaging and the name of the company manufacturing your contraceptive pill, nothing else has changed significantly. Zelleta[®] is just as effective at preventing pregnancy.

Things to remember when taking Zelleta[®]

Do read the Patient Information Leaflet carefully.

You can also download a replacement leaflet from www.zelleta.com if you lose or misplace the leaflet that was provided in the box with your Zelleta[®].

Do order your new prescription in plenty of time.

Please make sure that you contact your surgery to order your replacement supplies of contraceptive pills **when you start the third cycle of your Zelleta[®] pack**. This will help you to make sure that you leave sufficient time to get your new contraceptive prescription dispensed so that you do not interrupt or reduce your contraceptive cover.
